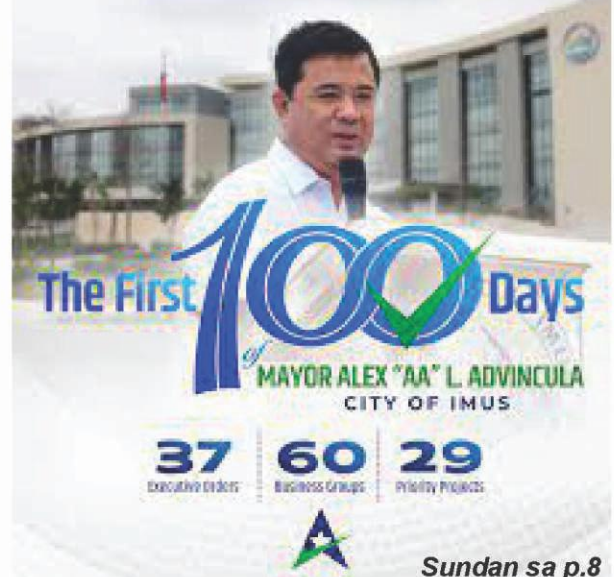

DIGONG DUTERTE: NO QUARREL WITH MARCOS

PARTIDO Demokratiko Pilipino-Laban ng Bayan (PDP-Laban) president Rodrigo Duterte said he has no quarrel with the current administration.

Duterte, former president of the Philippines said: "I would like to make this thing very, very clear. We are not putting up a strong party against the party of the President (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' Marcos Jr.), we are not

going to quarrel with him. Far from it."

Known for his monicker Tatay Digong, Duterte said after his reelection as PDP-Laban president that his party "will be giving our full support for Marcos politically."

"He was elected by 31 million. I wish the President good luck and I hope he would govern this country in accordance to

what is the mandate of the people's interest," Tatay Digong explained.

Duterte, however, said that he will not hesitate to speak up if he sees any wrongdoing against the people.

Remulla na isinulat niya sa English:

"I am both a father and the Secretary of Justice, roles that I take very seriously. We all know about unconditional love, but at 38 years old, he (his son) will have to face his predicament as a fully

emancipated child.

"I have to abide by the oath of office I took when I assumed this position.

"To make everything clear:

"I will not intervene in nor influence my son's

predicament, and I have not done so in any way.

"A person should always face the consequences of their actions and I will let justice take its own course.

"I thank the PDEA (Philippine Drug

Enforcement Agency) for doing their job without fear or favor. I have no conflict with them. This is a very difficult time for me and my family. But this is nothing compared to what so many Filipinos are going through.

"I will respect the justice system and I wish my son a path to redemption."

Remulla leads the Philippines' delegation in Geneva, Switzerland for the 51st Regular Session of the United Nations Human Rights Council Enhanced Interactive Dialogue on the Philippines.

He is expected to be back on Friday, Oct. 14.

PBMM SIGNS SIM CARD REGISTRATION ACT

"Ang batas na ito ay tiyak na makatutulong sa pamahalaan upang paigtingin ang mga hakbangin laban sa mga scam at krimen na ginagawa sa pamamagitan ng text at online na mensahe."

Writing in Filipino, Marcos also known for his monicker PBBM said that the SCRA will ensure the personal information of every citizen.

"Masisiguro rin ng batas na ito ang seguridad ng personal na impormasyon ng bawat mamamayan," PBBM said.

The new law requires all public telecommunications organizations (PTE) or direct sellers all SIM card user to produce a valid identification document with a photo.

Unless the subscriber gives permission for access to his information, all information entered in SIM card registration will be kept as confidential.

In addition, the law requires telco companies to provide the full name and address listed on a SIM card registration upon receipt of a valid subpoena or court order.

The information on the SIM card holder may be requested in writing from telco companies by law enforcement agencies investigating alleged crimes committed using phones.

PBBM said that the

new law will greatly strengthen government efforts to combat text and internet message scams, which have victimized many citizens.

House version of the law (HB No.14) was sponsored by Speaker Martin Romualdez and Ilocos Norte Representative Ferdinand Alexander 'Sandro' Marcos 3rd and Tingog partylist Reps Yedda Marie Romualdez and Jude Acidre.

HB No. 14 was consolidated with Senate Bill No. 1310 sponsored by Senators Juan Miguel Zubiri, Grace Poe, Win Gatchalian, Joel Villanueva, Ronald Dela Rosa, Joseph Victor Ejercito, Jinggoy Ejercito, Cynthia Villar, Nancy Binay, Christopher Lawrence Go, Francis Tolentino, Imee Marcos, Ramon Bong Revilla, Jr., and Pia Cayetano.

In a related development, Information and Communications Sec. Ivan Uy that Filipinos can use passports or driver's licenses when they register their SIM cards due to the backlog or delay in the distribution of the national ID.

Uy explained that other IDs are definitely insecure that is why he chose passports and driver's licenses as alternative to the national ID in registering SIM cards.

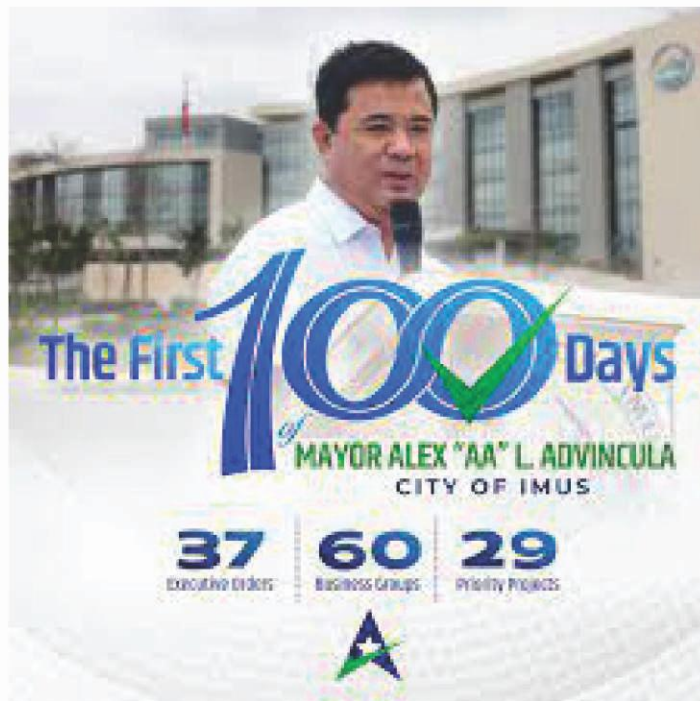
