## Pag-IBIG home loans reach P76.94B

Pag-IBIG Fund officials in a statement Friday, September 15, said the agency has released P76.94 billion in home loans in the last eight months, breaking its record on the highest home loan disbursement for any January to August period.

Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) Secretary Jose Rizalino Acuzar said that he is happy to report that Pag-IBIG Fund has once again set a record high in terms of home loan releases during the first eight months of the year.

"The sustained growth of our home loans mean that more and more Filipino workers are being helped by Pag-IBIG Fund to have homes they can call their own. This is one of our ways to heed the call of President Marcos to provide sustainable and inclusive housing for Filipinos," said Sec. Acuzar who heads the 1-member Pag-IBIG Fund Board of Trustees.

He added that the amount of home loans released by the agency during the period is P4.23 billion or 6 percent higher compared to the P72.71 billion released during the same period in 2022, and financed 59,840 homes of Pag-IBIG Fund members.

## Legalize marijuana: 63% ng Pinoy



Sa artikulong lumabas sa MAILYONARO.COM.PH, tinanong ng Capstone-Intel Corp. ang 1,205 na Pinoy na may edad 18 hanggang 75 anyos ang naniniwalang ito na ang panahon na payagan ng gobyerno na gamiting pamalit na gamot ang marijuana.

Ginawa ang survey mula Agosto 1-10, 2023.

Umabot sa 71% ng respondent sa Davao region ang pabor na gawing legal ang marijuana, sinundan ito ng 69% sa Soccsgaren at 69% naman sa Metro Manila.

A delegation of journalists from the Guangxi Radio and Television in China recently visited the construction site of the Kaliwa Dam Project, a high-quality project undertaken by China in the Philippines under the Belt and Road Initiative.

The Kaliwa Dam Project is an important cooperation project between China and the Philippines, as well as a crucial part of the Philippines' New Centennial Water Source Project (NCWSP).

It is reported that the Kaliwa Dam Project is a concrete gravity dam, with a designed height of 73 meters and a 247-meter crest. A 21.9-kilometer water diversion tunnel is currently underway, which plays a significant role in controlling the project.

Ryan James Eisen, the representative of the Philippine

owner unit of the Kaliwa Dam Project, said that China Energy Engineering Group Co., Ltd. ## PCO'S MEDIA INFORMATION LITERACY CAMPAIGN GETS HREP'S NOD

The Presidential Communications Office (PCO) has earned the approval and support of the House of Representatives on its Media and Information Literacy (MIL) campaign, which will primarily target equipping teachers in state universities and colleges (SUCs) to combat fake news, misinformation and disinformation.

Marikina City's 2nd district representative, Congresswoman Stella Luz Quimbo, PCO's budget sponsor, said that the agency is eyeing to expand its target group for the campaign should Congress agree to increase its allocation in the succeeding years.

"Gusto po natin as broad-based as possible, kaya nga lang ang realidad, napakaliit po ng budget na nakalaan sa ngayon. Kaya ang first phase po natin ay state universities and colleges (SUCs). But, of course, with the generosity of Congress in the coming years, baka sakali po ay madagdagan ang ating target groups," she said.

ACT TEACHERS Party-list representative, Congresswoman France Castro, assured the PCO that she will support its efforts on the MIL campaign, and also agreed on the planned increased budget for it.

"Kaisa po ako ng PCO dito sa program na ito o project na proposed digital media and information literacy campaign at sumasang-ayon ako sa ating kagalang-galang na

sponsor na madagdagan ang budget kaugnay noon. Ako po ay susuporta po sa mga ganoong panukala," she said.

The government's lead communications arm is proposing a P 16.899 million allocation for its MIL campaign from its P1.7 billion proposed budget for the year 2024.

According to Quimbo, the agency will be initially targeting to equip teachers on MIL in SUCs, who will in turn impart the knowledge they learned to their students.
