Government Betrays Poor Students

Half a million of the Philippines' poorest high school graduates have been denied the chance to pursue college—not because they lacked the will, but because government abandoned them. The damning report from EDCOM II is not just a statistic; it is a verdict on the failure of the Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) under the so-called "free tuition law."

In 2021, over 500,000 senior high school graduates came from 4Ps families, the very

sector the subsidy was created to uplift. Yet only 495 students—yes, less than one-tenth of one percent—actually received support. To call this a scandal is an understatement. This is betrayal institutionalized by neglect, a state policy that parades as pro-poor but functions as exclusionary.

Even more outrageous, no new TES slots were opened for three academic years. If these graduates had been given their rightful aid, many would now be finishing their

college degrees. Instead, the nation has manufactured a "lost generation"—young Filipinos who were forced to abandon dreams because leaders could not deliver on a law they bragged about.

"This is not merely a problem of bureaucracy. It is a crisis of priorities. Billions are allocated to confidential funds, debt payments, and vanity projects, yet the poorest are left to gamble on college enrollment with no guaranteed lifeline.

newable energy is widely adopted, agriculture adapts to climate change, and growth opportunities extend even to rural areas.

With the national theme “Siyensiya, Teknolohiya at Inobasyon: Kabalikatan sa Matatag, Maginhawa at Panatag na Kinabukasan” and the regional banner “Building Smart and Sustainable Communities,” this year’s RSTW highlights how emerging technologies, local innovations, and commu-



The celebration commenced alongside the GeoRisk PH Summit, highlighted by the signing of a memorandum of agreement for the regional rollout of the GeoRisk Philippines Integrated Platform. This digital system serves as a one-stop hub for hazard assessments, mapping tools, and real-time analytics—supporting disaster risk reduction, evidence-based planning, and policy development

for local governments and stakeholders.

In his keynote message, DOST Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr. stressed the importance of harnessing STI to build resilience and foster inclusive development. He emphasized that through strong partnerships among government, the private sector, and local communities, it is possible to envision a future where disasters are less destructive, re-



nity-driven solutions

can address pressing challenges and drive regional progress. Participants are expected to engage in forums, explore interactive exhibits, and experience technology demonstrations from DOST and its partners.

A major highlight of the week is the 2025 STI Awards, which recognized outstanding beneficiaries of DOST programs such as the Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP), Community Empowerment thru Science and Technology (CEST), and Grants-in-Aid (GIA). From entrepreneurs developing unique



products to farmer groups adopting modern technologies, this year’s awardees exemplify how science and innovation directly uplift lives and strengthen local industries.

As Secretary Solidum noted, the honorees prove that science is not confined to textbooks or laboratories—it is about lives improved, livelihoods uplifted, and futures secured.

Another key feature was the signing of a partnership among the DOST-Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI), DOST Region VIII, and the Local Government Unit of Bobon, Northern Sa-

mar.

The collaboration seeks to enhance fiber extraction technologies from abaca and pineapple, transforming agricultural by-products into sustainable raw materials for the textile sector while creating new livelihood opportunities in local communities.

Running until September 5, the 2025 RSTW in Eastern Visayas stands as a regional showcase of innovation and collaboration—affirming that science and technology are vital in building resilient, future-ready, and inclusive communities. **(Nelson Santos)**



Advocacy for public school teachers

Pursuant to the Department of Education (DepEd) Memorandum No. 067, series of 2025 and CO-EPS No. 08-350, the National Teachers' Month (NTM) is being celebrated from September 5 to October 5, 2025, and October 5 is slated as the National Teachers' Day (NTD) and World Teachers' Day.

Accordingly, the celebration aims to: 1) honor and recognize teachers for their vital role in nation-building by nurturing learners, families, and communities; 2) revitalize respect for teaching as a noble profession; and 3) generate public support and gratitude for their

invaluable service and influence on Filipino learners.

The above aims are sufficient reasons to give importance to the roles that the public school teachers are serving. They are the frontliners in educating the youth of the country. DepEd teachers have a major responsibility of teaching and training young kids under basic education, the very foundation of learning among the youth of the country.

However, they are considered as the most neglected human capital of the nation. Majority of them are underpaid and underemployed compared to their counterpart men-

tors at the State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), and the CHED and TESDA Supervised Institutions (CSIs/TSIs).

The author's advocacy for the DepEd teachers started on August 13, 2009 with his article "Teaching and rewards" published in The Philippine Star bearing an unsolicited advice for the officials of the Department of Education (DepEd) to review the nomenclature of the position classification and compensation of CSIs and TSIs under National Budget Circular (NBC) No. 461.

If government could equate the positions and compensation of

DepEd with that of CSIs and TSIs, say positions as teacher I-VI with respective Salary Grades from 11 to 16 and master teacher I-VII with SG 17-23, respectively, then there are so many steps in the career path for the DepEd teachers to look up to and possibly be achieved.

It was followed-up with his article "Why I devoted my productive life to teaching" published in The Manila Times on March 14, 2019, likewise asking DepEd to pursue the said review.

On February 12, 2020, the Business Mirror published his article "Upgrading Teachers' position classification and compen-

sation: A solution to salary dilemma of public school-teachers" detailing the process as indicated in NBC 461.

Likewise, on June 4 and 11, 2020, The Manila Times published his two-part article titled "Public schools teachers must be valued in PH society", pursuing the said advocacy.

His advocacy for them got responses from the government. Thus, Executive Order No. 174 series of 2022, dated June 23, 2022, also known as "Establishing the Expanded Career Progression System for Public School Teachers," was issued.

After two years, on July 26, 2024,

finally, the ceremonial signing on the subject was conducted, involving key government agencies — the DepEd, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Civil Service Commission (CSC), and the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC). Led by Education Secretary Juan Edgardo Angara, the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) have been signed for the said EO.

This happened after President Ferdinand Marcos, Jr., in his third State of the Nation Address (SONA) on July 22, 2024, declared that "We have allotted funds to finally implement the expanded career pro-

gression system for our public school teachers, which shall promote professional development and career advancement within their ranks. This expanded system lays out two major career paths for our teachers to pursue: the teaching; and the school administration tracks, each of which shall have ample career growth opportunities. With this system in place, we will accelerate the career growth of teachers."

So that on July 31, 2024, the article "Bravo: Public school teachers!" was published by the Business Mirror, the author appreciating the concerted efforts exerted by the concerned government offices.

Lately, the country's legislators gave ample attention to the plight of public school teachers.

House Bill No. 10270 and its counterpart Senate Bill No. 2831 titled "Institutionalizing the Career Progression System for Public School Teachers and Appropriating Funds Therefor" reached third reading in both Houses of Congress during the 19th Congress.

At present, it is still hoped that the advocacy for the DepEd teachers will be pushed through. This advocacy for them needs to be realized for their continued motivation and inspiration.
