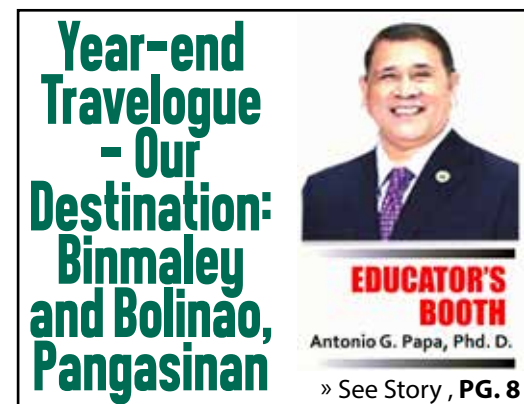

# Lacson urges PBBM to intensify his anti-corruption campaign

Senate President Pro Tempore Ping Lacson is publicly urging President Bongbong Marcos to intensify his anti-corruption campaign in 2026.

The senator from Cavite said public anger over corruption—especially the flood control scandal—has reached a point that national leaders “can no longer ignore.”

Lacson hopes Marcos will “not waver” in pursuing accountability, especially after the President’s strong remarks in his 2025 SONA against “shameless” corruption in infrastructure projects.

Marcos in his January 1, 2026 New Year message called on Filipinos



to enter 2026 with: Discipline, Confidence and Unity and shared purpose.

He acknowledged

the political divide and public outrage over the corruption scandal, urging Filipinos to



choose “empathy over indifference” and “service over self-interest.”

In another development, Executive Secre-

tary Ralph Recto said that Marcos will sign the P6.793-trillion 2026 national budget in the first week of January 2026, not before year-end as originally expected.

This avoids a long reenacted budget scenario, though a short delay of a few days was anticipated.

Malacañang stated that Marcos is prepared to absorb the political consequences of his intensified anti-corruption campaign.

Palace press officer, Atty. Claire Castro said that despite negative survey ratings in December 2025, the President remains

committed to pursuing accountability in anomalous flood control projects.

During the last months of 2025, Marcos faced major pressure from corruption scandals and political infighting with the Duterte camp.

Despite large protest and demands for his resignation over alleged kickbacks in flood control projects, the President remained in power.

Internationally, Marcos gained attention for his stance in the West Philippine Sea and his upcoming role as ASEAN Chair for 2026.

nanakaw ng koryente at ang kapabayaan ng mga kompanya ng elektrisidad na habulin ang mga magnanakaw ng elektrisidad.

Paliwanag ng kongresista, sa loob ng maraming dekada, pinagbabayad ang kaniwang pamilyang Pilipino sa elektrisidad na hindi sila ang gumamit.

“This practice is not only unfair, it is also fundamentally unjustified,” sabi ni Mercado-Revilla.

Kung maamandahan ang Pilferage Act, mismong kompanya ng elektrisidad ang papasahan sa pagkalugi mula sa ilegal na aktibidad ng mga magnanakaw ng koryente, at sa nawalang kita na dulot ng kalamidad at iba pang mga dahilan.

Sinusuportahan ng pahayagang ito ang panukalang batas ni Congw. Mercado-Revilla, at hinihikayat ang mga mambabatas na ipasa ito agad – upang mapagaan ang hirap sa bayarin ng mahihirap na pamilyang Pilipino.

on public safety and accountability under the PNP Focus Agenda on Enhanced Managing Police Operations (EMPO), aligned with the national vision of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. for a safer and more orderly Philippines.

Among those arrested were Top 2, Top 3, Top 4, Top 6, Top 9, and Top 10 Most Wanted Persons involved in serious crimes such as murder, syndicated

estafa, statutory rape, and other heinous offenses, apprehended through coordinated operations by police units in Central Luzon, CALABARZON, Bicol, Western Visayas, NCR, and other key areas.

All arrested individuals are now under proper police custody and facing due legal processes.

In the campaign against illegal drugs, police units also recorded significant

gains. In Kalinga, authorities destroyed 7,000 fully grown marijuana plants valued at P1.4 million during a large-scale eradication operation. Meanwhile, a joint buy-bust operation in the Cebu City led to the arrest of a High-Value Individual (HVI) and the seizure of 1,030 grams of shabu worth P7.4 million.

Acting Chief PNP, PLTGEN Jose Melencio C. Nartatez Jr. said the early accomplishments

send a clear message as the new year begins.

“We are starting 2026 with firm and focused police action. These results show that our personnel remain vigilant—even during the holidays—because public safety does not take a break,” PLTGEN Nartatez said. “This is about protecting communities, enforcing the law fairly, and making sure that criminals are held accountable.”

He added that these

operations underscore the PNP’s continuing transformation under the current administration.

“Under the guidance of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr., we will continue strengthening our operations through EMPO—smarter deployment, tighter coordination, and faster response. This is how we deliver police service that our people can truly feel,” he stressed.

## Sara Duterte’s corruption issue no longer discussed publicly – analyst

Political analyst and UP-NCPAG senior lecturer Prof. Lester Balmatero said that corruption allegations against Vice President Sara Duterte are no longer at the forefront of public discussion, one of the reasons why her survey ratings remain high.

In an interview on Bilyonaryo News Channel’s Agenda, award-winning broadcast journalist Korina Sanchez-

Roxas asked Balmatero whether Vice President Sara Duterte’s high survey ratings are connected to her public announcement that she plans to run in the 2028 presidential election.

“Yes, yan yung isang reason. Pero tingin ko yung Vice President naman kasi kadalasan insulated siya doon sa performance ng administration because yung Vice

President ay hindi naman siya part (nagpapatakbo) ng government,” he said.

“Lahat ng problema ng taumbayan sa pagkain, kagutuman, mataas na presyo ng bilihin, trabaho, tapos ito nga korapsyon mako-connect mo siya doon sa present administration, doon sa presidente. Kaya to some extent insulated yung Vice President natin,”

Balmatero added.

Balmatero also said that the corruption issues against Duterte are no longer the focus of public discussions.

“Mukhang hindi na masyado napagusapan yung corruption issues related to the Vice President,” he said.

“Pero tignan natin, tingin ko this coming February or March merong movement para possibly mag-file ulit

ng impeachment complaint against VP Sara,” the professor added.

According to the Pulse Asia survey conducted from December 12 to 15, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. posted a 34% approval rating and 48% disapproval rating.

His trust rating was 32% while his small/no trust was 47%.

Meanwhile, Duterte posted a

## Qualified Unjust Vexation by Atty. Sui Generis

Unjust vexation "as any human conduct, which, although not productive of some physical or material harm, would unjustly annoy or irritate an innocent person. Its purpose is to cause annoyance, irritation, torment, distress, or disturbance to the mind of the person to whom it was directed. (Renato Baleros Jr. vs People of the Philippines GR 138033 Feb. 22 2006)

Further, if it is accomplished with the use of information and communication technology, the penalty may be increased by one degree from arresto menor (imprisonment ranging from 1 day to 30 days) to arresto mayor (imprisonment ranging from 1 month and 1 day to 6 months) in accordance with Section 6 Republic Act (RA) No. 10175 or the "Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012," which provides that:

"All crimes defined and penalized by the Revised Penal Code, as amended, and special laws, if committed by, through and with the use of information and communications technologies shall be covered by the relevant provisions of this Act: Provided, That the penalty to be imposed shall be one (1) degree higher than that provided for by the Revised Penal Code, as amended, and special laws, as the case may be."

Kailangan lamang ay isang kasapi ng UN ang magpahayag ng pagkilala sa independence of Mindanao upang masimulan na ang proseso ng pagiging isa nitong malayang bansa.

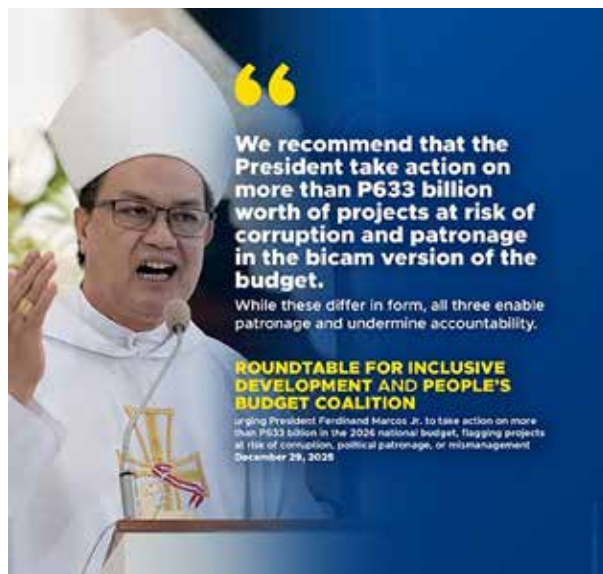

## Civil Society groups urge Marcos to veto or condition budget items worth P633B to prevent patronage, corruption



Civil society groups urged President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. to take action on more than P633 billion in the 2026 national budget, flagging projects at risk of corruption, political patronage, or mismanagement.

The joint letter from the Roundtable for Inclusive Development and the People's Budget Coalition commended increases in the education and agriculture budgets, the funding of Project NOAH, and early steps by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and PhilGEPS toward greater transparency.

However, the groups warned that "shadow pork," "soft pork," and "hard pork" in the budget still enable patronage and undermine accountability.

Key recommendations include:

- Veto P243 billion in

unprogrammed appropriations ("shadow pork"), citing violations of Supreme Court rulings and constitutional principles.

- Transform P210 billion in discretionary aid programs and confidential funds ("soft pork") into rights-based, rules-based initiatives or subject them to conditional implementation, ensuring politicians do not select beneficiaries.

- Place over P600 billion in infrastructure projects ("hard pork") under multi-sectoral citizen monitoring and require DPWH to update design manuals for science-based and nature-based flood control, roads, and bridges.

The letter also called for systemic reforms, including an Open Budget Transparency Server, multisectoral review committees for future budgets, and the urgent passage of bills on budget transparency, FOI, independent oversight commissions, and political party reforms.

"Buwis natin ito. Budget natin ito," the groups emphasized, urging the administration to ensure that every taxpayer peso benefits the nation.

The letter was signed by Cardinal Pablo Virgilio David, Ramon Del Rosario Jr., Kenneth Abante, and Hyacinth Bendaña, representing the Roundtable for Inclusive Development and the People's Budget Coalition.

# Year-end Travelogue – Our Destination: Binmaley and Bolinao, Pangasinan

Binmaley is a first class municipality belonging to the second congressional district in the province of Pangasinan, Philippines with a population of 88,006 people in 2024 census. Meanwhile, Bolinao is also a first municipality belonging to the first district in the province of Pangasinan. And in the 2024 census, it has a population of 84,658 people (Wikipedia).

Myself and my wife Amelita, together with 9 members of the family started our journey from Indang, Cavite to Pangasinan at exactly 1:20 am on December 29, 2025. We arrived at Barangay Gayaman, Binmaley, Pangasinan at 7:30 am. We had our breakfast there, then we paid a visit to my wife's deceased parents and brother.

We used to visit the place yearly when my Father-in-law is still alive and celebrating his birthday every December 29th. He died in 2021 before reaching his 90th birthday. Lita's mother died in 2001 and her brother on April 5, 2024.

Lita's living siblings, her eldest brother and wife are currently living in Tabaco, Albay while the family of her youngest brother resides in San Diego, California.

For our journey from Binmaley to Bolinao, Pangasinan, we travelled for more than two hours at a distance of around 95 kilometers going to Barangay Patar, Bolinao, Pangasinan. Barangay Patar is one of the three barangays having established resorts. The other barangays are Ilog Malino, and Balingasay. In Barangay Balingasay, guests could experience a Balingasay River Cruise with a floating restaurant.

By the way, Bolinao, Pangasinan, is a true gem in the Philippines, offering a rich blend of natural beauty, history, and adventure. From the stunning white sands of Patar Beach to the cascading waters of Bolinao Falls and the historical charm of the Cape Bolinao Lighthouse, the town's diverse attractions make it a must-visit destination. Whether you are a nature lover,

history enthusiast, or adventure seeker, the variety of Bolinao tourist spots ensures that there is something for everyone.

Accordingly, Patar Beach in Bolinao is one of the top tourist destinations in the Philippines, aside from Boracay Beach in Aklan, El Nido Beach in Palawan, various tourist spots in Baguio City, and Tagaytay City in Cavite for the famous Taal Lake and Volcano.

Meanwhile, when we are travelling going to the target destination, I really wondered why our hired van is approaching a mountainous place while our trip is the Patar Beach, of course a seaside, in Bolinao, Pangasinan.

But, when the van goes down to a rustic place and I saw a lighthouse from above—the historic Cape Bolinao Lighthouse, then my mind says 'bravo', at last we will be approaching the scenic sea.

## The historic Cape Bolinao Lighthouse



The Cape Bolinao Lighthouse is a must-visit Bolinao tourist spot, which stands on top of a hill, overlooking the vast ocean. Built in 1903, this lighthouse has been a guiding light for sailors for

over a century. Visiting the Cape Bolinao Lighthouse offers not only a chance to explore a piece of history but also to take in panoramic views of Bolinao's coastline. This spot is especially magical during sun-



set, offering a perfect backdrop for photography enthusiasts. This lighthouse is not only a navigational aid but also a symbol of Bolinao's rich maritime heritage.

For our journey, the first thing that we did after reaching Barangay Patar, we located our pre-contracted

driver rested at one of the two bamboo nipa huts called "kubo". By the way, our air conditioned room in the kubo has a television set, while the receiving area is equipped by a two-feet refrigerator, where our insulin was stored during the whole duration of our stay in the place. We were housed there from 1 pm on December 29 and we singed out at 11 am on December 30.

On one hand, Elling's Patar Place is one of the 10 transient houses owned and operated by the families of Erlinda Hondrada-Caslib who has nine siblings and the property is located in the upland area with around half-a hectare property. The front section of the area is allocated as the parking lot of the guests.

On the other, Elling's Patar Place is being managed by spouses Gerard and Jackielou Manzano-Caslib. Gerard is one of the four children of Erlinda and Ildefonso Caslib, Sr. The place

was established in 2018 with just one kubo and a small building with two rooms.

Currently, the Elling's Patar Place has two kubos and a three-storey building, where the first floor has three air-conditioned rooms, second floor with four air-conditioned rooms, and the third floor with one big air-conditioned room and a rooftop ready for party occupancy. According to both the spouses, they could attain more than a million-peso gross income this year—2025.

On our part, after lunch in the place, the group explored the

serenity of the Patar Public Beach. The other members of the group swam, played volleyball in the beach, and took photos.

The Patar Beach is known for its white sand and crystal-clear



waters. It is one of the most iconic Bolinao tourist spots. It is the perfect place to relax, swim, and enjoy a stunning sunset over the South China Sea. With its idyllic setting, Patar Beach attracts both locals and tourists looking for a serene escape from the busy city life. Whether you want to lounge on the beach or take a refreshing swim.

At 4 pm, we followed the group at the Patar Beach. We, myself and my wife, stayed there for a sightseeing until sunset. We enjoyed the sunset over the South China Sea.

After dinner, we rested and prepared



ourselves for another journey the following day. After breakfast, the younger members of the group went back to Patar Beach for swimming.

At 11:30 am, we proceeded to the Bolinao Falls. Bolinao Falls is a top choice among the many Bolinao tourist spots. The three falls

have crystal-clear waters cascading down a series of rock formations and offers a refreshing escape into nature. Visitors can swim, cliff dive, or simply relax by the cool waters of this picturesque waterfall.
