New Impeachment complaint may be filed February vs VP Sara

A major story from the South China Morning Post highlights criticism over the Armed



Forces of the Philippines' decision to retain VP Sara Duterte as commander of an Army reserve unit, despite her past incendiary remarks.

This contrast is being interpreted as a sign of the deepening rift between Marcos Jr. and Duterte ahead of 2028.

News reports said House leaders say a new impeachment complaint against VP Duterte may be filed next month (February 2026), even

though the Supreme Court has not yet resolved the House's appeal regarding the 2025 impeachment ruling.

This keeps the political pressure on her office.

At the Senate, Sen. Sherwin Gatchalian clarified that impeachment was not discussed during the 2026 budget deliberations, countering Sen. Imee Marcos' claim that the budget was being used to revive impeachment efforts.

In another develop-

ment, a separate global news cycle compared the arrest of Venezuela's Nicolás Maduro to the earlier arrest of former President Rodrigo Duterte.

This is not directly about VP Sara, but it keeps the Duterte name in international political discussions.

This means in the broader political landscape the intensifying political tension between the Marcos and Duterte camps.

Former Ilocos Sur Governor Chavit Singson publicly urged Filipinos – including religious groups, civil society, and people "from left or right" – to join a "one-time, big-time" rally aimed at denouncing alleged corruption in government flood-control projects and pressuring President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. to resign.

In a press conference the other day, Singson said the rally should happen "as soon as possible", and that he would personally reach out to religious organizations to mobilize them.

She emphasized that encouraging people to overthrow the president meets the legal definition of sedition, though it is up to the Department of Justice (DOJ) to investigate and decide whether

ernment agencies and private entities, including educational institutions, are conducting drills to avoid too much damage both to people's lives and properties.

All sectors are educating their respective constituents through various seminars and training programs to prepare them when this event happened.

and be prepared for, according to authorities:

--If the strong earthquake strikes and you happen to be inside a home or a building, remember to do the "duck, cover and hold"; stay away from objects which might fall; then quickly leave the area after the quake and head straight to the near-

est evacuation area. --Stay away from trees, buildings, and electrical post and head on to an open area, if you are outside. Also, ensure that the injured, elderly, children, expectant mothers, and person with disability will be prioritized.

--Before an impending tsunami hits a particular region, especially the coastal areas, make sure that you are aware of the evacuation plan in your community, participate in drills, and designate a meeting point of the family or neighborhood.

--After the disaster happens, leave the evacuation area only if you are told to do so by the LGU authorities, check if someone is missing, and bring the injured to the nearest medical facility.

--These catastrophes are like thieves

in the night. We can never be a hundred one percent ready but preparedness is definitely workable beforehand.

The above information are very helpful tips, the proper disaster education to learn, so that when The Big One occurs, readiness is the key for safety reaction.

If people are serious in preparing to mitigate the effects of The Big One, they must also be very serious in preparing for the "Real Big One".
