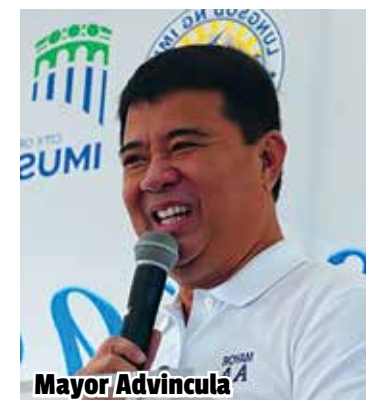

Sa pamamagitan ng maayos na pakikitungo sa isang witness. At pagkalap ng maghahalagang impormasyon, mabilis na pagkilos ng Scene of the Crime



Operatives (SOCO) Team from the Cavite Provincial Forensic Unit arrived at the scene to conduct forensic processing, matahimik na ang kaluluwa ni alias Ed.

Kahit na pagod, mainat na nakuha ng SOCO team ang mga kailangan sa imbestigasyon: limang basyo ng bala ng isang

.380 caliber firearm ang naidokumento, dinala sa forensic at ballistic labs at inexamina.

acknowledged the call of Sen. Marcos for a temporary suspension but

benefit.

Marcos argument is that with fuel prices and basic commodities surging due to the Middle East crisis, workers should be allowed to take home their full salaries for now.

PhilHealth also confirmed that it is actively studying the call of the senator but the agency emphasized that the law (RA 11223) requires continuous premium payments.

Top PhilHealth officials are currently consulting with economic managers and awaiting guidance from Malacañang.

While no suspension has been approved yet, PhilHealth is offering:

- A one-time waiver of penalties for overdue premiums (for employers and self-paying members).
- A one-year window for employers to settle missed contributions from July 2013 to December 2024.

This means that no suspension of PhilHealth premiums has been implemented as of the latest updates and that the proposal is under consideration, but any change will require coordination with the executive branch and compliance with existing laws.

And I exhort, "Travel south or north, the home brings me the best comfort."

For me, the home is not only my source of comfort against inclement weather conditions but also my dwelling place when I am afflicted with some psychological, social and environmental discomfort.

Yes, when the household climate and culture are both too favorable, here, the members

step-by-step process of building a character family, according to the book, "Achieving True Success: How to Build Character as a Family" (2000).

Character building as a family can be boiled down into four Ps – the essential phases such as the: 1) perspective, 2) plan, 3) practice, and 4) procedure.

Perspective. The steps are as follows: 1) Take responsibility for

1) Step back and take a careful look at your home life, 2) make a list of goals for your family, and 3) sketch a plan for the pace, order, and method your character family will follow.

Practice. Successful character training includes the following elements: 1) Modeling good character, 2) praising good character, 3) teaching good character, 4) recognizing good character, and 5) correcting

resolution and explain that this is



a commitment to work on character as a family, and 4) share your plan.

As the head of the family, tell the members of the family that you will focus on the one character quality per month. As a family, members should learn about the quality, memorize the definition of and look for ways to apply it every day around the house, at school, at work and at play.

Family members can then report back during the next family meeting about the ways they applied the quality and the rewards that they across as a result.

Practice of Family Hour

At this juncture, the practice of the families inside the Church Of Christ or Iglesia Ni Cristo (INC) regarding "Family Hour" is commendable. It is being sponsored and implemented through the Christian Family Orga-
