LPG explosion: 2 people killed, 7 injured

Dasmariñas City — Two people died and 7 were injured after an LPG refilling/repair operation inside a residential house in Barangay Salawag, exploded around 9:00 a.m.

The blast caused a fire that damaged multiple houses and vehicles in the neighborhood.

The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)

declared the fire out at 9:55 a.m. The fatalities were identified as: A 65-year-old male employee, a 20-year-old nephew of the owner of the LPG business.

CCTV footage showed the moment just before the explosion, and residents described the blast as feeling like a bomb.

The house was being used as an unpermitted LPG repair

and repaint shop, according to the homeowners' association. Residents had previously complained about chemical smells and safety concerns.

Authorities are investigating, whether the LPG business had proper permits, the exact cause of the explosion and the possible liabilities of the operator.

Si Madriaga ay isa sa Top 5 Most Wanted Persons of the PNP Anti-Kidnapping Group. Dinakip siya base sa isang warrant na inisyung Manila Regional Trial Court at walang inirekomendang piyansa ang hukuman para sa anyang pansamantalang paglaya.

Ayon sa PNP Anti-Kidnapping Group, Ang

grupo ni Madriaga ay isa sa pinakamapanganib na sindikato ng mga kilabot na kriminal sa buong bansa. Sangkotang grupo ni Madriaga sa pagkidnap sa dalawang Chinese national at sa pagpatay sa isang opisyal ng Anti-Kidnapping Group sa isang engkwentro noong Hunyo 2022.
